ROOTS OF SUCCESS is a 10-module multimedia, activity-based curriculum and federally registered Apprenticeship and Pre-Apprenticeship program customized for youth and adults in job training programs and other community-based programs. The course is taught by Instructors who are trained and certified using a teaching approach and materials that are designed to immediately engage participants.

TO OFFER ROOTS OF SUCCESS programs schedule a Train-the-Instructor training for instructors who will teach the course. Instructors are provided with teaching materials, multimedia content, are enrolled in the Apprenticeship and receive ongoing technical assistance and mentorship. A few weeks before the course begins, programs order Student Workbooks for participants and enroll them in the Pre-Apprenticeship. Upon completion, graduates receive Roots of Success and Pre-Apprenticeship Certificates that are highly valued by employers and educational institutions. In some settings, graduates also receive college credit.


